### 16 Credit Certificate

**Entrepreneurship, certificate, 16 credits:** The Entrepreneurship Certificate is designed to meet the educational needs of business and entrepreneurship. The program offers a combination of traditional academics, and individualized (1:1) instruction. The four core courses (Intro to Entrepreneurship, Entrepreneur Business Plan, Legal Environment of Business, and Entrepreneur Marketing) are each broken into three one credit segments to meet the dynamic needs of entrepreneurs. There are several options for the required four credits of elective courses to complete the certificate.
