



Installing and using the YouTube Add-in for Power Point 2007

What is YouTube?

YouTube is a video sharing website where users can upload, view and share video clips. YouTube was created in mid-February 2005 by three former PayPal employees. The San Bruno-based service uses Adobe Flash technology to display a wide variety of video content, including movie clips, TV clips and music videos, as well as amateur content such as video blogging and short original videos. In October 2006, Google Inc. announced that it had reached a deal to acquire the company for US\$1.65 billion in Google stock. The deal closed on November 13, 2006.

Unregistered users can watch most videos on the site, while registered users are permitted to upload an unlimited number of videos. Some videos are available only to users of age 18 or older (e.g. videos containing potentially offensive content). The uploading of pornography or videos containing nudity is generally not allowed. Related videos, determined by title and tags, appear onscreen to the right of a given video. In YouTube's second year, functions were added to enhance user ability to post video 'responses' and subscribe to content feeds

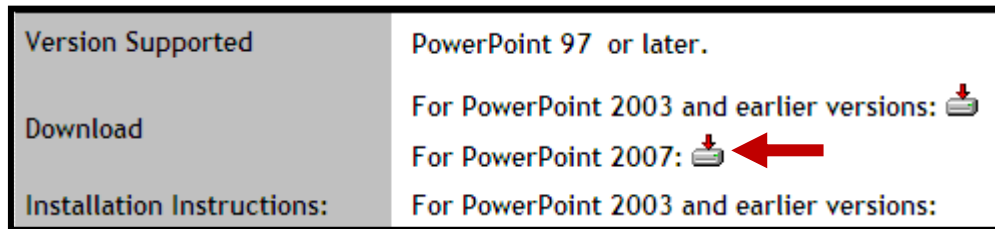

- Triggers for discussion
- Engage students in course content-Students today use digital media regularly in their everyday life. YouTube gives students a digital aspect on the content that is being taught.
- When having students produce videos and then post them on YouTube, they not only get feedback from their instructors but also from people all around the world. It gives a new meaning to "It takes a village".
- Higher order thinking skills- students are asked to create a video to illustrate a concept in a course.

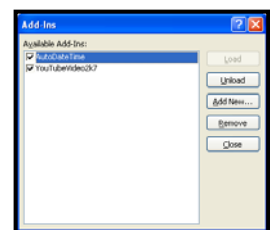
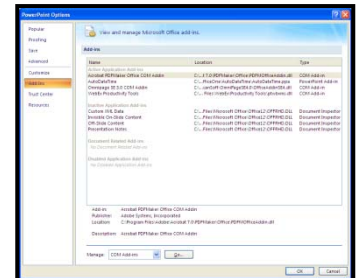
Downloading the Add-in

1. Click on the appropriate **download link** for your version of Office at this website.
<http://skp.mvps.org/youtube.htm>
2. When asked to Open or Save, *save* the **file** to your **desktop**.
3. *Navigate* to the **Zip file** you just saved on your desktop and *double-click* it to **open it**.
4. Click on the **Extract all Files** option on the left side of the zip window.
5. The Extraction Wizard will start. Click **Next** through the wizard screens.
6. Click **Finish**.



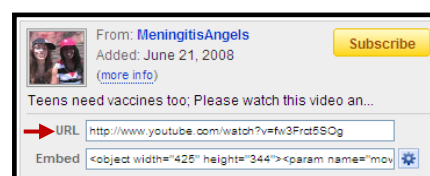
Installing the Add-in

1. Launch PowerPoint 2007.
2. Click on **Office Button**.
3. Click **PowerPoint Options**.
4. Select the **Add-ins** tab.
5. Select **PowerPoint Add-ins** from the *Manage* drop down and click **Go**.
6. Click **Add New** on the Add-ins dialog box.
7. *Navigate* to the **folder** where the content of the **zip file** was extracted.
8. Select **YouTubeVideo2k7.ppa**
9. Click on **OK**.
10. You might be prompted with the macro virus warning. *Enable* the **macros**.
When the Add-in is properly loaded, it will display a check in front of the add-in name.
11. You have successfully loaded the add-in!



Using the YouTube for Power Point 2007 Add-in

1. Choose your **video** from the YouTube website.
2. Copy the **URL link** found to the right of the video.
3. Click the **Insert Tab**.



4. Click on the **YouTube Video control**.



5. Paste the **URL** to the YouTube video by using **CTRL + V**.



6. Provide the **additional info** required. (You may want to change the size of the video) YTV will create the slides with Flash control embedded on the slide.
7. Run the **slide show**. The video will be displayed during the slide show.



***Note!** *This method of using YouTube videos in Power Point 2007 requires a live internet connection when running the presentation in order to work correctly.*
