Auto Body Reapir is a 2,000 hour course designed to give the graduate a basic understanding of the trade, through observation, demonstration, and practical experience. Much of the practical experience is given on cars belonging to the general public. The student starts making minor repairs on older cars and pickups and then progresses through all the steps of repairing and refinishing until he finally repairs complete wrecks. 



This is an eighteen month course divided into two nine-month sessions for a total of 2,000 hours. The objectives of the first session are to familiarize the student with the fundamentals of the auto mechanics trade. This is accomplished by studying theory in the classroom, learning manipulative skills by shop instruction and developing these skills by practice in the repairing and overhauling of engines, electrical systems, fuel systems, brakes, steering gears, power trains, exhaust emission control, automatic transmissions, and wheel alignment and balancing. In the second nine-month session, the students work full-time on actual jobs, to improve on skills and quality of work in an environment approximating that of future places of employment.



In the airframe section the student will receive theory and practical experience in air-craft fabric and finishing, aircraft woodworking, sheet metal and welding, hydraulics, aircraft electricity, and electrical systems, inspect-ion and trouble shooting, utility systems, instruments and helicopters. The first year Electronics course covers the fundamentals and basic principales, basic radio theory and servicing the superheterodyne receiver, basic electronic communications and related test instruments. During the second year the student studies televisions and their many varied types of cricuits, followed by industrial electronics, which includes such devices as voltage and current regulators, timing circuits and radio frequency remote control circuits. Integrated circuits are then studied and used to build multivibrators, counters, shift registers which leads into the study of computer circuits, such as data transfer, methods of input-output, data storage and computer languages.




