ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

Admission and Graduation Requirements

- B. Students accepted into **receiving college or university** must fulfill the **receiving program/award** graduation requirements.

Transfer of Credits

- A. **Receiving college or university** will accept **number of credits** credits from **Northland Community and Technical College's sending program/award** to apply to its **receiving program/award**. **Number of credits** credits remain to complete the receiving program and award.
- B. Courses will transfer as described in the Program Articulation Table included in this Articulation Agreement.

Terms of Agreement

- A. The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.

- B. Program curriculum and requirements listed in the Program Articulation Table may change.
