APPLYING FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

To apply for the 2026-27 academic year, the student must complete this application and the 2026-27 FAFSA.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship will cover any remaining tuition and fees after the student's federal Pell Grant and state grants have been applied to the student's account. Up to \$1,000 for books, tools, and supplies will also be available.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

The student must be enrolled in a non-associate of arts program at Northland Community & Technical College, or other preapproved technical college, beginning in the semester following receipt of a high school diploma from the school indicated above.

FIRST-YEAR SCHOLARSHIP

The student must complete a 2026-27 FAFSA and enroll full time (minimum 12 credits per semester) in a non-associate of arts program.

SECOND-YEAR SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship will be renewed for the 2027-28 academic year if the student has met the following conditions:

- ▶ Successfully complete 24 credits during the 2026-27 academic year.
- ▶ Complete the 2027-28 FAFSA.
- ▶ Achieve a minimum GPA of 2.5 at the end of the 2026-27 academic year.
- ▶ Meet with an academic advisor at least once each semester.
