Statute 326B.974 - Subd. 2. School District Training

Effective August 1, 2010: A school district shall allow to occur annually at least eight hours of training related to boiler operation to a licensee described in sub division 1. The training must be administered by a licensed first or chief engineer during the licensee's normal working hours. **Two hours of the required training shall occur in the boiler room and must include demonstration of tasks associated with operating boilers.** The tasks associated with operating boilers acceptable for the training must be from the list of approved tasks supplied by the chief boiler inspector. The administrator of the training shall receive training credit for time spent administering training pursuant to this subdivision.
