The Thief River Falls AVTI Practical Nursing program is a member of the Agassiz Region Nursing Education Consortium (ARNEC). The ARNEC is a group of schools working together in an innovative approach to nursing education. The ARNEC offers a creative and flexible program to those interested in nursing education.

A number of schools in Northwestern Minnesota, along with schools in Minneapolis, Minnesota, and Grand Forks, North Dakota, developed this program. The program allows students the opportunity to complete nursing education at one level and have the option to later further his/her education and receive a higher degree. This option can be exercised immediately with the student continuing his/her education to the desired level or the student can graduate at one level, work, and later return for more schooling. This mobility is possible through curriculum development which is identical in each participating school. It is an excellent opportunity for the nursing graduate not available in most schools in Minnesota or in the nation.

Schools participating and the degree level offered include: Nursing Assistant at Bemidji, Crookston, East Grand Forks, and Thief River Falls; Practical Nursing at Bemidji, Crookston, and Thief River Falls; Associate Degree in Nursing at Thief River Falls; and a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing at Grand Forks, North Dakota, Minneapolis, Minnesota and Moorhead, Minnesota.

# Student Senate

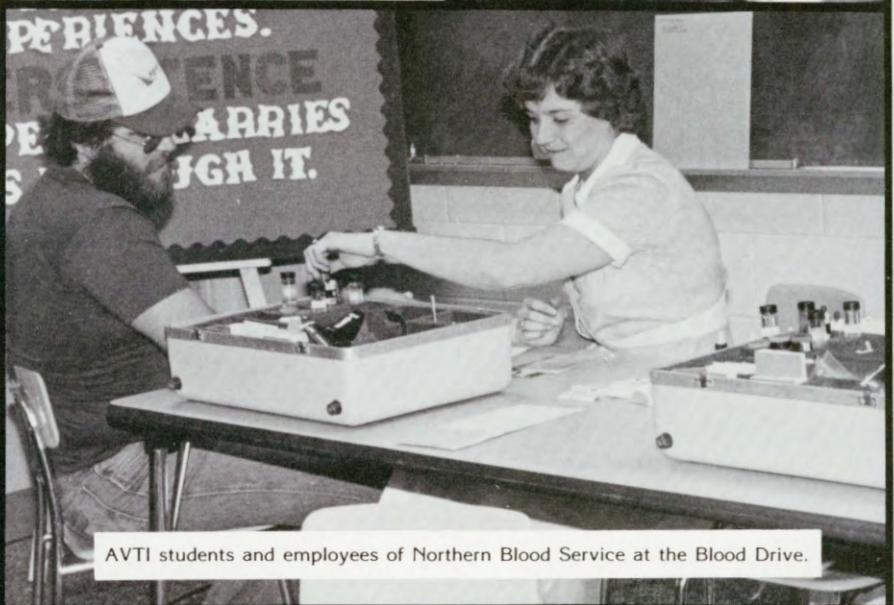

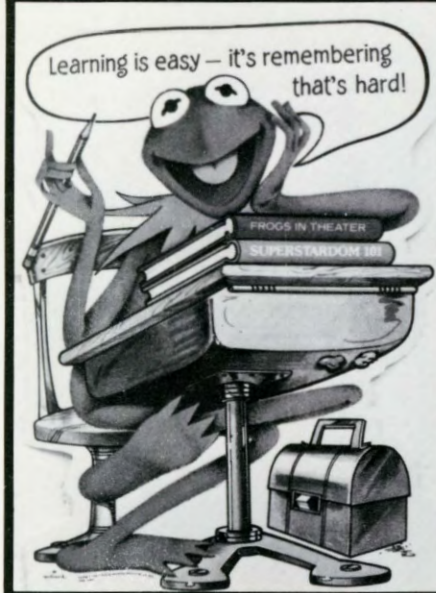

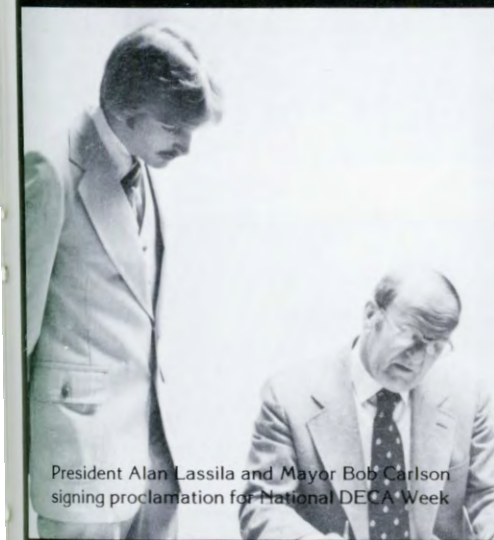


# D.E.C.A.

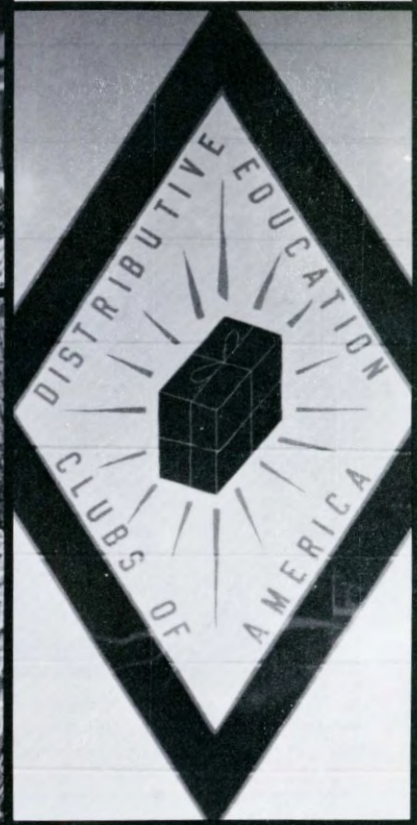

The Board of Education of Independent School District 564 establishes the policies for the operations of the school district within the State and Federal guidelines. They employ a Superintendent of Schools as their general administrator and hold him responsible for educational and operational management. The AVTI is included in School District 564.

In addition to the Board of Education, the AVTI, as required by the Law of the State of Minnesota, also works under the guidance of advisory committees.

An advisory committee is a group of citizens selected to collectively provide advice to the public school in regard to vocational education. The members are mostly from outside the field of education representing labor, management, and the general public. The members are selected because of specialized expertise and knowledge. They serve only as advisory, without administrative authority, and usually serve without pay or compensation. The General Advisory Committee assists in the development and maintenance of the entire vocational program of a school and a school district. They identify the needs of individuals and community; help assess labor market requirements; contribute to the establishment and maintenance of realistic and practical programs; participate in developing community understanding and support; aid in building the prestige of an respect for the entire program of occupational education; and, are concerned with long range goals.

Departmental Advisory Committees serve one occupational area in a vocational school. They assess programs according to local needs and suggest changes and additions for the curriculum.

An advisory committee doesn't automatically guarantee a successful program nor will it follow the committee function will be without problems and conflicts. But a school and its representative, realistically prepared and aware of what such a lay group can contribute, can draw from the experience which is required to build and maintain good, sound programs.

When the advisory role is not filled, the school and the community cannot benefit from the exchange between educator and committee that presses programs to more effective operation. More importantly, if the program function doesn't match its potential, the individual student is denied the maximum amount of help that could, and should, be available to him—help that comes only from the interaction of those who will educate and train him and those who will hire him.

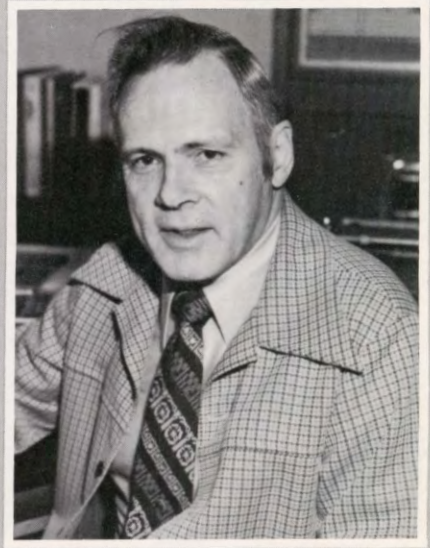

The Thief River Falls Area Vocational Technical Institute began its fourth decade of providing vocational technical training to the people of Northwestern Minnesota. Because of the AVTI's continual efforts to offer the most up-to-date vocational training and facilities in the State of Minnesota, it's always noted as an institute of change and growth.

This quality has been apparent since the AVTI began its operation in the fall of 1949. From this start, the AVTI has seen remodeling in 1957, the building of new facilities in 1967, and the construction of a new building addition in 1979.

From the original three programs, the school has grown to a total of 20 programs with a full time enrollment of over 450 students. In addition to the full time students, the institute serves about 3,000 others annually through afternoon and evening adult education programs offered throughout Northwestern Minnesota.

Because of the uniqueness, quality, and experience of the AVTI and its programs, students are attracted from throughout the State of Minnesota and several neighboring states.

The Area Vocational Technical Institute is approved by the State Department of Education. It is approved for training under the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, Veterans Public Law No. 95-202, and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

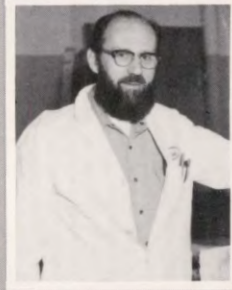

## Small Business Management

The main purpose of the Small Business Management Program is to assist business operators in achieving their business and family goals through the improved management, organization, and operation of their business.

Up-to-date records are kept of all business transaction and important family expenditures. At the close of each business year the records are analyzed to determine the strengths and weaknesses of the business.

Instruction includes monthly Instruction sessions held at the AVTI and individual instructions by the instructor at each business. During these visits the business family and instructor can study specific questions and problems pertaining to the individual business.

Using applied business management principles, instructors discover with the enrollees the strengths and weaknesses of their businesses. Through skills gained in this program, the weak points can then be minimized, allowing the business operator to make progress toward his/her established goal.

## Adult Farm Management

The Minnesota Vocational Agriculture Farm Management Program is available to all Minnesota farmers through a local Vocational Agricultural Instructor. The program is based upon the principles of management, education, and the development and achievement of goals. It is oriented toward the farm family, and its primary responsibility is to assist the family to reach its goals. The annual analysis program supplies the farmer with a computerized depreciation schedule and a very complete analysis of his/her farming operation. In addition, the farmer works with a farm management instructor who teaches basic accounting procedures and helps individuals to budget, interpret his/her analysis, plan operations, and plan credit needs. The ag man also helps the farmer to keep up with the latest agricultural developments.

This program has grown rapidly. Farmer's credit sources and agribusinessmen enthusiastically endorse it. This year there are over 900 farmers in Northwestern Minnesota participating in the program and 5,000 enrolled in the whole state of Minnesota. The program now extends into North Dakota, Alaska, Oregon, Connecticut, Nebraska, Washington, Wisconsin, South Dakota, Iowa, and Idaho.

To enroll, contact your local Vocational agriculture instructor. If your school does not have a vo-ag department, contact the vo-ag coordinator at the Area Vocational Technical Institute. Any farmers in Minnesota may enroll. A fee is charged to cover the cost of preparing the analysis report. The present analysis fee is \$55 per record.

## Mine Safety

In October, 1978, the requirements for obtaining approval of training programs and specific kinds of training for miners under the Mine Safety and Health Act (MSHA) were proclaimed by the U.S. Department of Labor. The purpose of these rules is to insure that employees and employers in gravel, sand and quarry operations are effectively trained in matters affecting their health and safety, with the ultimate goal of reducing the frequency and severity of injuries in the nation's mines and gravel pits. MSHA requirements include statutory rights of miners, self-rescue, first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, transportation controls and communications health emergency evacuation plans, firefighting, ground controls, electrical hazards, health protection, prevention of accidents, and explosives.

The regional instructor/coordinator works with three advisory committees to determine the specific training needs of the mining and gravel industry in the region. He contacts these operations to make them aware of their responsibility to the training requirements, develops instructional materials for the 8-hour training program and conducts in-service training for other MSHA instructors throughout the region. He has implemented training for approximately 500 persons since the program began in 1979.
