




POPE SHOT - Pope John Paul II was seriously wounded in an assassination attempt in St. Peter's Square in Rome.


VIOLENCE IN IRELAND — Unrest continued in Ireland. Belfast was the center of violence as rioting tore through troubled Northern Ireland in the

wake of the death of IRA hunger striker Bobby Sands. He, along with other IRA members, carried out a hunger strike protest from their jail cells.





DODGERS TAKE SERIES — After losing the first two games, the Los Angeles Dodgers came back to defeat

the New York Yankees and take their first World Series title in 16 years.






AVTI students spent several days picketing in the community to encourage an end to the stalemate. Their only objective—a settlement! For four long weeks the teachers 'walked' and the students waited. Finally the doors to the school buildings in the District were opened and classes resumed.

The strike is now history. Whether the actions of the AVTI students had an effect on negotiations, no one can be sure. One thing is sure, however, the feelings and memories of the month-long strike will long be remembered.

Once school was back in order the Senate went on with planning activities for the 1981-82 school year. Activities included: fall picnic; blood drives; Fall State Senate Convention in Alexandria; Halloween Dance; Valentine's Dance; March-in-to-spring week activities; Spring Senate Convention in Hibbing; spring intramural softball; spring picnic; spring banquet.





AVTI Students on Northland Teams

The Board of Education of Independent School District 564 establishes the policies for the operations of the school district within the State and Federal guidelines. They employ a Superintendent of Schools as their general administrator and hold him responsible for educational and operational management. The AVTI is included in School District 564.

However, the AVTI, as required by the law of the State of Minnesota, also works under the guidance of advisory committees.

An advisory committee is a group of citizens selected to collectively provide advice to the public school in regard to vocational education. The members are mostly from outside the field of education representing labor, management, and the general public. The members are selected because of specialized expertise and knowledge. They serve only as advisory, without administrative authority, and usually serve without pay or compensation.

The General Advisory Committee assists in the development and maintenance of the entire vocational program of a school and a school district. They identify the needs of individuals and community; help assess labor market requirements; contribute to the establishment and maintenance of realistic and practical programs; participate in developing community understanding and support; aid in building the prestige of and respect for the entire program of occupational education; and, are concerned with long range goals.

Departmental Advisory Committees serve one occupational area in a vocational school. They assess programs according to local needs and suggest changes and additions for the curriculum.

An advisory committee doesn't automatically guarantee a successful program nor will it follow that committee function will be without problems and conflicts. But a school and its representative, realistically prepared and aware of what such a lay group can contribute, can draw from the experience which is required to build and maintain good, sound programs.

When the advisory role is not filled, the school and the community cannot benefit from the exchange between educator and committee that presses programs to more effective operation. More importantly, if the program function doesn't match its potential, the individual student is denied the maximum amount of help that could, and should be available to him—help that comes only from the interaction of those who will educate and train him and those who will hire him.

The Thief River Falls Area Vocational Technical Institute began its fourth decade of providing vocational technical training to the people of Northwestern Minnesota. Because of the AVTI's continual efforts to offer the most up-to-date vocational training and facilities in the State of Minnesota it is always noted as an institute of change and growth.

This quality has been apparent since the AVTI began its operation in the fall of 1949. From this start, the AVTI has seen remodeling in 1957, the building of new facilities in 1967, and the construction of a new building addition in 1979.


From the original three programs, the school has grown to a total of 20 programs with a full time enrollment of over 500 students. In addition to the full time students, the institute serves about 3,000 others annually through afternoon and evening adult education programs offered throughout Northwestern Minnesota.

Because of the uniqueness, quality, and experience of the AVTI and its programs, students are attracted from throughout the State of Minnesota and several neighboring states.

The Area Vocational Technical Institute is approved by the State Department of Education. It is approved for training under the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, Veterans Public Law NO. 95-202, and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.




