**REFRIGERATOR** — 302 lb. rookie William "The Refrigerator" Perry helped lead the Chicago Bears to a Super Bowl win.

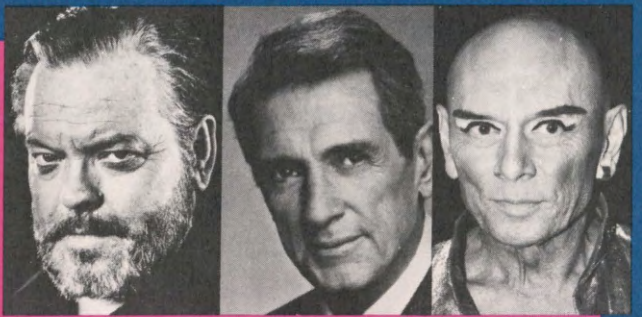
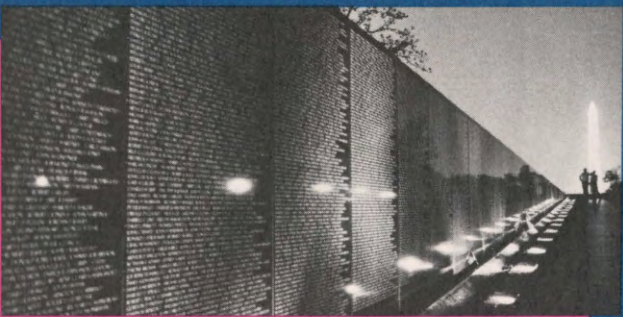

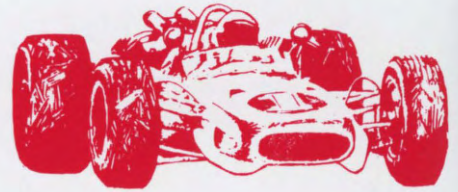
## **AUTO- BODY REPAIR**

The Auto Body program offers educational classroom training in a real life setting. Students learn all phases of auto body repair from minor damage repair to the restoration of a total wreck in a modern equipped facility. This 72 week program provides students with the knowledge required in all techniques of auto body repair including estimating, equipment usage, and shop maintenance as well as experience in the classroom run shop which is very similar to a privately owned body shop.



## **AUTO MECHANICS**

Auto Mechanics is a 72 week program which covers all phases of automotive repair. The first year emphasizes theory of automotive engines, electrical systems, chassis, transmission and fuel systems with some hands on experience. The second year students learn advanced automotive technology and work on customer cars in a real life situation which is much like a commercial automotive repair shop. Students learn on four different brands of analyzing scopes in preparation for the various work situations that they may encounter after completion of the program.

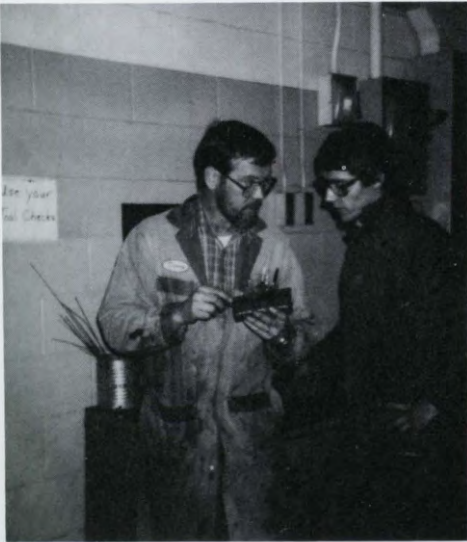






## **WELDING**

The Welding program is individualized so that students may advance at their own rate. A student's capability will determine his/her completion date. The shop equipment is all very new. Some of the new equipment consists of a six foot ½" squaring shear, an iron worker, a plasma arc cutting machine, a digital read-out wire feeder, aluminum wire feeder and a pipe beveling machine. Several types of certification tests are given including A.W.S., A.S.M.E., and the Minnesota Department of Transportation Certification test.





## ***Practical Nursing***

The Practical Nursing Program at the Thief River Falls AVTI is designed to prepare practical nurses in proper patient care techniques. The practical nurse gives direct patient care in uncomplicated and relatively stable situations with minimal supervision and assists the registered nurse and/or licensed physician to provide nursing care to patients whose needs are more complex.

A student entering Practical Nursing should possess a good background in math, science, and communications. The student must have good judgement, pleasing personality, neat appearance, a good moral character, and must enjoy working with people. Completion of high school or the equivalent is necessary. Applications for this program must be received by the November 15th preceding the anticipated starting date.







## ***Cosmetology***

The Cosmetology program instructs students in the proper methods relating to the cosmetic care of the hair, nails, and skin. Students will experience realistic situations by working on patrons in an actual salon setting under the guidance of highly qualified instructors.

After the student has completed 1350 hours of instruction a Minnesota state theory, hours and skills exam will be assessed and passed at a competency level. At completion of 1550 hours, a Cosmetology license will be acquired allowing the licensee to seek employment performing acquired skills on hair, skin, and nails. Prior to taking the state board exams, a student must show successful completion of high school or the equivalent.





# Accounting

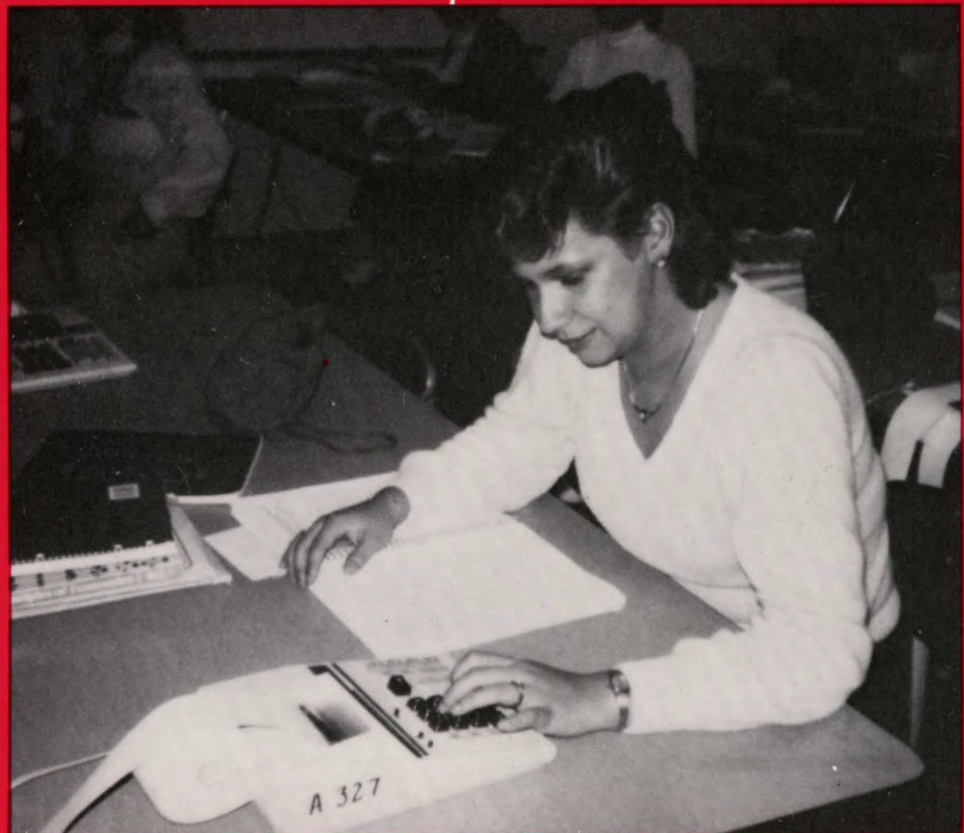
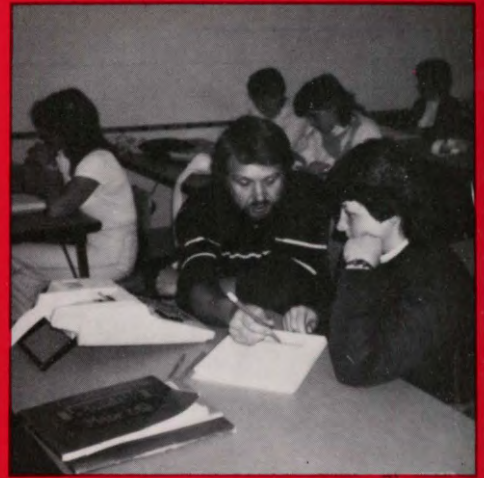
The Accounting program is a two-year course consisting of a 10 month term and a 9 month term. Instruction is provided in the application of accounting principles for sole proprietorship, partnerships, and corporations. Students will learn to maintain proper accounting records using both a manual system and a computer system utilizing an IBM System 36 and microcomputers. The curriculum is designed to prepare the student for possible employment in the following areas: banks, corporations, small businesses, public accounting firms, tax consulting firms, and government offices.

# Legal Secretarial

The Legal Secretarial program offers the opportunity for an exciting career in the field of law. General secretarial skills are combined with specialized legal courses and training in word processing and computers. Students are trained on modern, up-to-date equipment, including electronic typewriters, IBM Displaywriters, and IBM Personal Computers.

Legal Secretarial students have the option of taking short-hand, Gregg or Forkner systems are offered.

Graduates of the Legal Secretarial Program can expect to find employment in private law firms, banks, insurance companies, corporate legal departments, financial institutions and government offices.

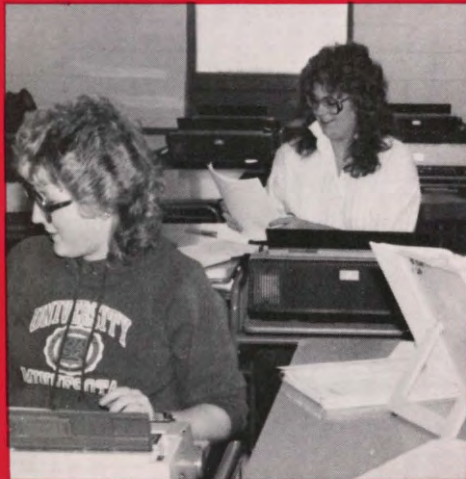






## ***General Secretarial***

The secretarial duties in an office consists of all the business communication. Some of the tasks of the secretary include taking shorthand, typing, filing, handling telephone calls and setting up appointments. In addition, one might be assigned particular tasks such as arranging travel schedules, compiling statistical records, and recording minutes of meetings. Special emphasis is placed on shorthand and typing training at the AVTI, since these areas are most used by secretaries. Two forms of shorthand are offered: Intermediate and Advanced Gregg Shorthand; Beginning and Intermediate Forkner Shorthand.



## ***Medical Secretary***

Today's medical profession is becoming large and more specialized resulting in the necessity for qualified assistants. This demand directly affects the need for qualified medical secretaries. To assist the student obtain the goal of becoming a medical secretary, the 10-month Medical Secretarial program provides nine months of classroom instruction and 120 hours of supervised work experience to bridge the gap between the classroom and the world of work.



# Broadcasting

The world of announcing is one of excitement, variance, and challenge. It opens many fields to those who choose Broadcasting as a career. After completion of the program the student will be skilled in board operation, news, weather, sports, play-by-play sportscasting, radio programming, automation, and sales. Students will also be trained for closed circuit television, TV spot news recording, as well as production of TV commercials.

The AVTI operated FM Radio Station KSRQ, utilizes the ABC Broadcast Network and newsprint from the Associated Press. This enables the Broadcasting class the opportunity to utilize an excellent selection of broadcast equipment found at most AM and FM radio stations. Students work in four well equipped studios using computer, broadcast type reel to reel tape decks, control consoles, cart machines, and a remote marti unity that enable KSRQ-FM to carry high school and college sports and other events.

Television programming incorporates as much of the curriculum as possible into the closed circuit presentations to give students hands-on education in a television studio. The TV studio utilizes a complete range of necessary closed circuit TV equipment. Three hours a day is spent working on TV programming and television production. The balance of time is spent working in a classroom situation on materials and course objectives.





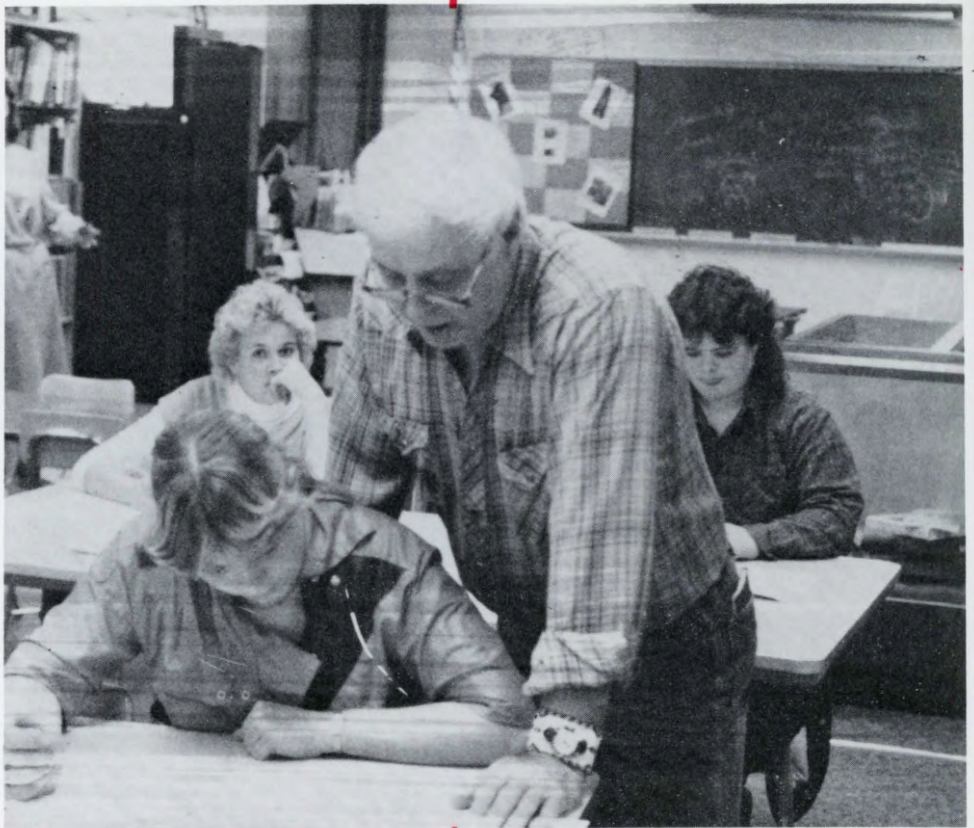


## ***Airframe & Powerplant Technology***

Aviation Mechanics are a very special and select group of people. They are trained for a unique skill that is in demand throughout the world. A student of Aviation Mechanics will be trained for repair in aircraft electrical systems, hydraulics, inspection and troubleshooting, utility systems, fuel injection, engine overhaul, turbo jets, propellers, turbo prop engines and all other parts of airplanes. Upon completion of the course the student will be a graduate of one of the 120 Federal Aviation Agency approved schools in the nation.



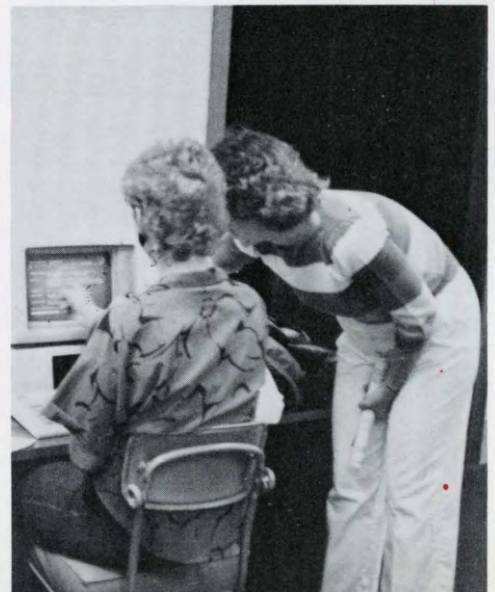




## *Adult Education*

We extend a welcome to all citizens to participate in the adult program and remind you to make suggestions for vocational courses of interest to you.



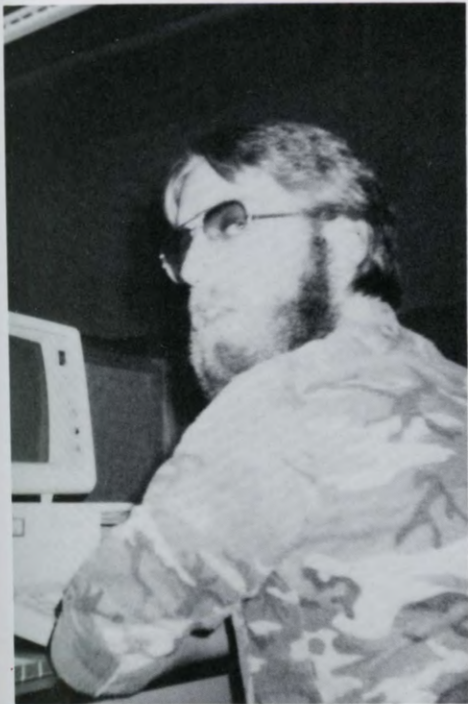


# Architectural Drafting & Design

Architectural designers and drafters are involved in the start of the construction process. They are the persons who initiate the form which a structure will take. These people should be able to visualize and present their thoughts in two and three dimensions.

In our program we give the student the basic knowledge in construction and architectural procedures to enable them to work with architects, engineers, design firms, contractors, lumber yards, building suppliers, government agencies, and many other related areas.

Architectural Drafting I and Architectural Drafting Technician are the diplomas offered in our personalized, continuous, two year program.

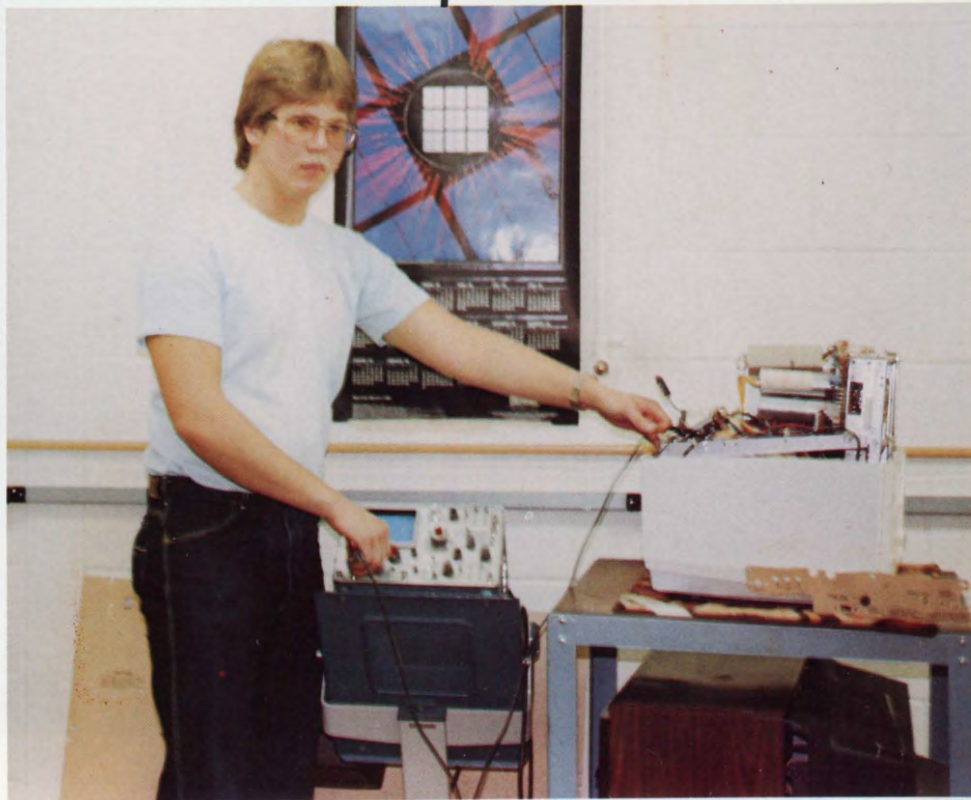




## Electronics

The Electronics program has made many changes in the past couple of years. A new satellite receiver system has been installed for viewing educational programming and instruction in TVRO (television receive only) installation and maintenance. Robotic arms are being used as instructional tools to demonstrate and teach microcomputer interfacing with external devices. Programming courses in BASIC, PASCAL, and machine language are being taught to improve the student's skills in microcomputer application.

The third year optional program provides a student who is an Electronics Technician the opportunity to return for specialized training or to continue specialized training after the two year program.







## ***Sales, Marketing & Management***

The Sales and Marketing program is a ten month program which provides instruction in advertising, display, marketing and sales techniques. The course content provides background for any students desiring to enter any sales or business occupation. Course work explores all areas of the Business world. Students will have the opportunity to choose the Business Management or Fashion Merchandising Option.

**HIJACK** — For 17 days, Shi'ite terrorists held hostage 39 passengers and crew members from TWA flight 847. One American was killed.

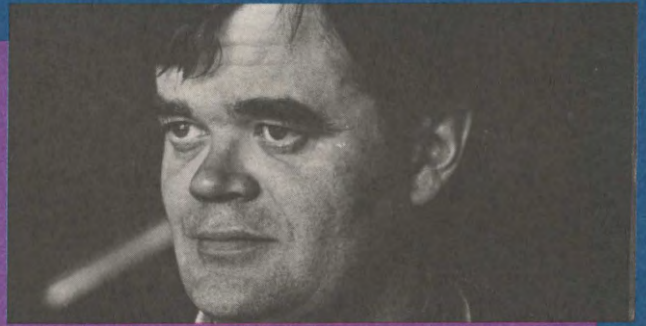
**ACHILLE LAURO** — Palestinian terrorists hijacked the Italian Cruise Liner. American Leon Klinghoffer was killed.
