

4010 EMERGENCY CLOSING AND CANCELLATION POLICY

Emergency closings and cancellations are defined as those situations that make it impossible to carry on the normal instructional activities of the College and/or create situations that could be harmful to the safety of students, employees, or college visitors. Some examples are weather-related situations, bomb threats, or utility failures.

When emergency conditions merit closing or cancellation considerations, the administration shall follow the College's adopted Emergency Closing Procedure.
