

6010 Parking Policy

Parking is provided in various parking lots, subject to regulations adopted by Northland Community and Technical College. Northland is authorized to establish and enforce traffic and parking regulations on campus by Minnesota Statute Section 169.966, Subd.8 (1988).

Only those vehicles owned or operated by college employees, students or other persons having a purpose or function at the college may park on college property.

All persons parking vehicles on property that is owned, leased or occupied by the college will do so at their own risk. No responsibility will be assumed by the college or the state because of loss of property, damage to vehicle while parked, damage which may be incurred through the process of impounding the vehicle, or for any other damage or loss sustained while on the college parking facility.
