

ECONOMICS TRANSFER PATHWAY

The Economics Transfer Pathway AA degree requires a completion of a total of 60 credits, 40 of which must be taken from the MNTC Goal Areas 1 – 10. A 2.0 GPA is required in the 40 credits of the MNTC. Transfer courses with grades of A – D will be included in the GPA calculation for the MNTC. (Numbers in parentheses denotes other goal area that may fulfill two areas of the transfer curriculum).
