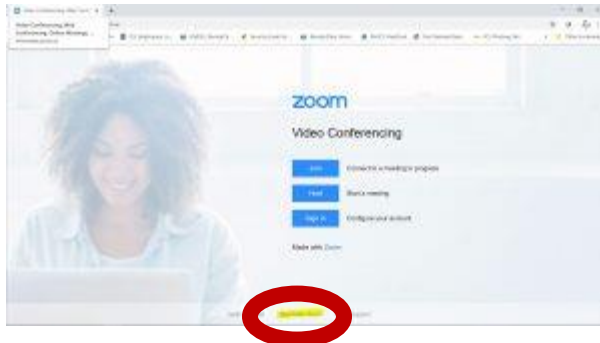


How to install the Zoom client and sign in for the first time.

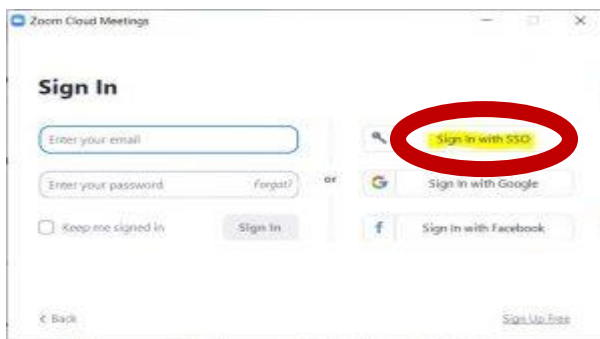
1. Go to the following website: <https://minnstate.zoom.us>
2. At the bottom of the page click **Download Client**.



3. This will open the **Download Center**.
4. Select the appropriate download version and follow the prompts.
5. When a pop-up window prompts the question –
Do you want to allow this app to make changes to your device?
Click **YES** button
6. Then click **Sign In**.



6. On the Zoom Sign in screen, select **Sign in with SSO**.



7. On the Sign in with SSO dialog box, type **Minnstate** and click **Continue** button.

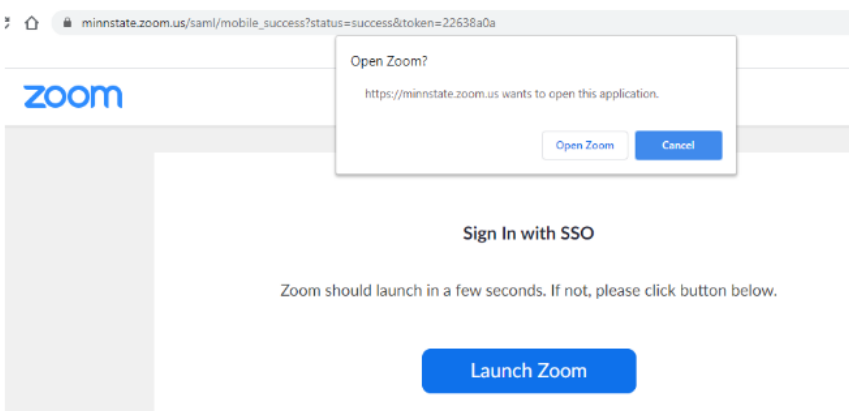


8. A browser window will open. Type your **StarID** and **StarID password**. Click the **Sign on** button.

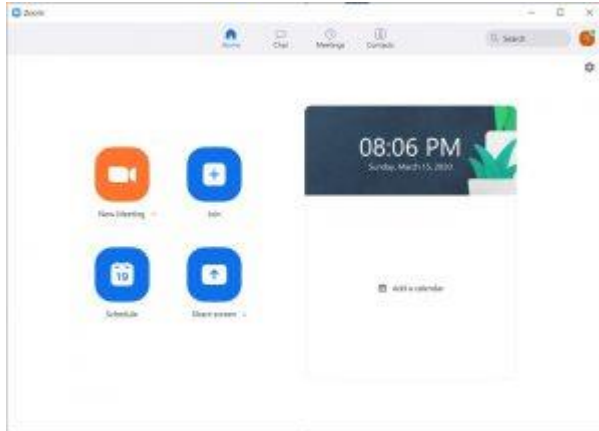


9. This will open the Launch Application box.



click **Open Zoom**
